## Rapides Parish Public Schools Show Marked Growth in District Performance

ALEXANDRIA, La.— The Louisiana Department of Education (LDOE) released 2024 performance scores today. The results show another increase for Rapides Parish Public Schools. The performance score for **the district increased from an 80.8 to an 83**. RPSB remains a B-rated school district, and this score marks the highest performance rating under the current accountability framework for the state.

Four schools improved by a letter grade in performance. There are now 27 schools in Rapides Parish that are ranked as an "A" or "B". 57% (25 out of 42) schools improved their overall school performance scores. 17 schools have been named "Top Gains" by LDOE.

Last year, RPSB ranked 51st in the state for growth. This year, the district ranks 19th.

ACT Index growth has been significant, with students across the district improving their composite score and also excelling on the WorkKeys assessment. RPSB is **20th out of 69 districts in terms of growth with the ACT Index**.
