

The Eufaula City Board of Education met in regular session Tuesday, May 18, 2021, in the board room at Central Office. Members present were: Mrs. Twana R. Purifoy Anderson, Mrs. Yadira Chavez, Mrs. Caty H. Richardson, Ms. Katrina L. Wright, and Mr. Richard W. Wingate. The notice of this meeting was posted on the public bulletin board in the central office on June 16, 2020. A reminder was sent electronically on May 13, 2021 to a list of people who request board meeting information.

1. Mrs. Caty H. Richardson called the meeting to order at 5:33 p.m. A quorum was established with all members present. Mr. Richard W. Wingate moved for the board to approve the agenda as presented, and Ms. Katrina L. Wright seconded the motion. Motion was approved with a unanimous vote. Voting was as follows: “AYE” – Anderson, Chavez, Richardson, Wright, and Wingate. “NAY” – None.

2. Delegations/Awards

3. Mrs. Caty H. Richardson called for the approval of the minutes from the March 16, 2021 board meeting. Ms. Katrina L. Wright moved that the minutes be approved and Mrs. Yadira Chavez seconded the motion. Motion was approved with a unanimous vote. Voting was as follows: “AYE” – Anderson, Chavez, Richardson, Wright, and Wingate. “NAY” – None.

4. Superintendent's Report:

- ALVA submitted their monthly update to the board.
- Mr. Brandon Kiser, principal, presented a brief overview of Admiral Moorer Middle School.

5. Financial Statements and Bank Reconciliations:

- The March 2021 financial report for the system was reviewed and discussed. 52.82% of revenues have been collected, and 42.64% of the budget has been expended. The financial statement presented included all reconciled bank accounts for the Eufaula City Board of Education as of March 31, 2021. The Board was notified of this from Chief Financial Officer by statement noted on the Financial Report.

6. New Business:

- A. Election of Board President and Vice-President: Ms. Katrina L. Wright made a motion for Mr. Richard W. Wingate to serve as president. Mrs. Twana R. Purifoy Anderson seconded the motion. Motion was approved with a unanimous vote. Voting was as follows: "AYE" – Anderson, Chavez, Richardson, Wright, and Wingate. "NAY" – None. Mr. Richard W. Wingate made a motion for Mrs. Yadira Chavez to serve as vice-president. Mrs. Twana R. Purifoy Anderson seconded the motion. Motion was approved with a unanimous vote. Voting was as follows: "AYE" – Anderson, Chavez, Richardson, Wright, and Wingate. "NAY" – None.
- B. Board Compensation: Mrs. Twana R. Purifoy Anderson recommended that the members of the Eufaula City Board of Education forego compensation. Ms. Katrina L. Wright seconded the motion. Motion passed with a unanimous vote. Voting was as follows: "AYE" – Anderson, Chavez, Richardson, Wright, and Wingate. "NAY" – None.
- C. 2021-2022 Code of Conduct/Student Handbook, Second Reading: The Superintendent recommended the board accept the changes as presented in the 2021-2022 Code of Conduct/Student Handbook. It was presented for review, according to policy, at the April board meeting. Mr. Richard W. Wingate moved to accept the recommendation as presented. Ms. Katrina L. Wright seconded the motion. Motion passed with a unanimous vote. Voting was as follows: "AYE" – Anderson, Chavez, Richardson, Wright, and Wingate. "NAY" – None.
- D. Performance Matters: The Superintendent recommended the board approve a contract with Performance Matters, a platform that will integrate all areas of Eufaula City Schools data into one portal. The amount is \$39,552.42 to be paid from ESSR-2 funds. Mr. Richard W. Wingate moved to accept the recommendation as presented. Mrs. Yadira Chavez seconded the motion. Motion

passed with a unanimous vote. Voting was as follows: “AYE” – Anderson, Chavez, Richardson, Wright, and Wingate. “NAY” – None.

- E. Bus Surplus Inventory: The Superintendent recommended the board declare 2014-01 Bus as surplus inventory so that it can be sold on govdeals.com. The repairs needed for this bus exceed the price of a new bus. ALSDE gave permission to sell a bus that still has years left on our fleet renewal. The new bus will be purchased with FY22 ETF/ATF funding. Ms. Katrina L. Wright moved to accept the recommendation as presented. Mrs. Twana R. Purifoy Anderson seconded the motion. Motion passed with a unanimous vote. Voting was as follows: “AYE” – Anderson, Chavez, Richardson, Wright, and Wingate. “NAY” – None.
- F. Additional 202 Day Psychometrist Position: The Superintendent recommended the board approve an additional psychometrist position to be funded with ESSR funds. Mrs. Yadira Chavez moved to accept the recommendation as presented. Mr. Richard W. Wingate seconded the motion. Motion passed with a unanimous vote. Voting was as follows: “AYE” – Anderson, Chavez, Richardson, Wright, and Wingate. “NAY” – None.
- G. Additional Assistant Principal Positions: The Superintendent recommended the board approve two additional assistant principal positions, location to be determined. Federal and general funds will be used to fund the salaries. Mrs. Twana R. Purifoy Anderson moved to accept the recommendation as presented. Ms. Katrina L. Wright seconded the motion. Motion passed with a unanimous vote. Voting was as follows: “AYE” – Anderson, Chavez, Richardson, Wright, and Wingate. “NAY” – None.
- H. Exceptional Student Services Specialist, New Position: The Superintendent recommended the board approve a new position and job description for an exceptional student services specialist to assist the special education department. The position will be funded with ESSR funds. Mrs. Twana R. Purifoy Anderson moved to accept the recommendation as presented. Mrs. Yadira Chavez seconded the motion. Motion passed with a unanimous vote. Voting was as follows: “AYE” – Anderson, Chavez, Richardson, Wright, and Wingate. “NAY” – None.
- I. Proposed New Position and Employment Term Revision: The Superintendent recommended the Board revise the Special Education Coordinator position to a Special Education Director position, effective July 1, 2021. Ms. Katrina L. Wright moved to approve the recommendation as presented by the Superintendent and Mrs. Twana R. Purifoy Anderson seconded the motion. Motion passed with a unanimous vote. Voting was as follows: “AYE” – Anderson, Chavez, Richardson, Wright, and Wingate. “NAY” – None.

J. Student Activities: The Superintendent recommended the board approve the student activities and fundraisers for Admiral Moorer Middle School and Eufaula High School including adding a new AHSAA approved sport, Girls Flag Football. Mrs. Yadira Chavez moved to accept the recommendation as presented and Ms. Katrina L. Wright seconded the motion. Motion passed with a unanimous vote. Voting was as follows: "AYE" - Anderson, Chavez, Richardson, Wright, and Wingate. "NAY" – None.
