

The Eufaula City Board of Education met in regular session Tuesday, March 16, 2021, in the board room at Central Office. Members present were: Mrs. Twana R. Purifoy Anderson, Mrs. Yadira Chavez, Mrs. Caty H. Richardson, and Mr. Richard W. Wingate. The notice of this meeting was posted on the public bulletin board in the central office on June 16, 2020. A reminder was sent electronically on March 12, 2021 to a list of people who request board meeting information.

1. Mrs. Caty H. Richardson called the meeting to order at 5:35 p.m. A quorum was established with three members present. A fourth member arrived during the superintendent's report, and a fifth member viewed the meeting remotely/virtually. Mr. Richard W. Wingate moved for the board to approve the agenda as presented, and Mrs. Yadira Chavez seconded the motion. Motion was approved with a unanimous vote. Voting was as follows: "AYE" – Chavez, Richardson, and Wingate. "NAY" – None.

2. Delegations/Awards –

The Superintendent and Mrs. Stacey Turvin recognized Rhonda Thomas, a second grade teacher at Eufaula Primary School as well as site coordinator for the Eufaula Primary School 21st Century Community Learning Center Afterschool Program, as being named a board member with the Alabama Community Education Association (ACEA). She will serve the southern region of Alabama.

3. Mrs. Caty H. Richardson called for the approval of the minutes from the January 26, 2021 board meeting. Mrs. Yadira Chavez moved that the minutes be approved and Mr. Richard W. Wingate seconded the motion. Motion was approved with a unanimous vote. Voting was as follows: "AYE" – Chavez, Richardson, and Wingate. "NAY" – None.

4. Superintendent's Report:

- ALVA submitted their monthly update to the board.
- Mrs. Stacey Turvin updated the board regarding federal programs information including EESR-2 and EESR-3 funds.
- Eufaula High School, Mr. Reeivice Girtman and staff briefed the board regarding Eufaula High School ACT, Career Technical Education program, and presented a new program, Tiger Tracks.

5. Financial Statements and Bank Reconciliations: The January 2021 financial report for the system was reviewed and discussed. 36.20% of revenues have been collected, and 36.72% of the budget has been expended. The financial statement presented included all reconciled bank accounts for the Eufaula City Board of Education as of January 31, 2021. The Board was notified of this from Chief Financial Officer by statement noted on the Financial Report.
6. New Business:
 - A. Eufaula Peewee Football Association Joint Use Agreement: The Superintendent recommended the Board approve a joint use agreement with Eufaula Peewee Football Association to use the Bill Buchanan Stadium for practices and games. Mr. Richard W. Wingate moved to approve the guide as presented by the Superintendent and Mrs. Yadira Chavez seconded the motion. Motion passed with a unanimous vote. Voting was as follows: "AYE" – Anderson, Chavez, Richardson, and Wingate. "NAY" – None.
 - B. Admiral Moorer Middle School Weight Equipment: The Superintendent recommended the board approve the purchase of six stations of weight equipment for the weight room at Admiral Moorer Middle School. Mrs. Yadira Chavez moved to accept the recommendation as presented and Mr. Richard W. Wingate seconded the motion. Motion passed with a unanimous vote. Voting was as follows: "AYE" - Anderson, Chavez, Richardson, and Wingate. "NAY" – None.
 - C. Eufaula High School and Admiral Moorer Middle School Cheer Guidelines: The Superintendent recommended the board approve amended guidelines for cheer for Admiral Moorer Middle School and Eufaula High School. Mrs. Twana R. Purifoy Anderson moved to accept the recommendation as presented and Mrs. Yadira Chavez seconded the motion. Motion passed with a unanimous vote. Voting was as follows: "AYE" - Anderson, Chavez, Richardson, and Wingate. "NAY" – None.
 - D. Cheer Competition: The Superintendent recommended the board approve for the Eufaula High School cheer team to travel out of state to Orlando, Florida for a cheer competition and pay the cost of the charter buses. The cost of the charter buses will be \$7,040.00. Mr. Richard W. Wingate moved to accept the recommendation as presented and Mrs. Twana R. Purifoy Anderson seconded the motion. Motion passed with a unanimous vote. Voting was as follows: "AYE" - Anderson, Chavez, Richardson, and Wingate. "NAY" – None.
 - E. Student Activities: The Superintendent recommended the board approve the student activities for Eufaula Elementary School, Admiral Moorer Middle School, and Eufaula High School. Mr. Richard W. Wingate moved to accept the recommendation as presented and Mrs. Yadira Chavez seconded the motion. Motion passed with a unanimous vote. F. 2021 Summer Learning Plan: The Superintendent recommended the board approve the summer learning plan for 2021. The plan includes estimated personnel positions to post, classes for kindergarten through twelfth grades. Mrs. Twana R. Purifoy Anderson moved to accept the recommendation as presented and Mrs. Yadira Chavez seconded the motion. Motion passed with a unanimous vote. Voting was as follows: "AYE" - Anderson, Chavez, Richardson, and Wingate. "NAY" – None.

G. 2021-2022 Teaching Positions: The Superintendent recommended the board to approve positions to be posted in the hope that by posting, interviewing, and offering positions early will help find candidates for hard to fill areas. Mr. Richard W. Wingate moved to accept the recommendation as presented and Mrs. Twana R. Purifoy Anderson seconded the motion. Motion passed with a unanimous vote.
