

The Eufaula City Board of Education met in regular session Tuesday, May 17, 2022, in the board room at Central Office. Members present were: Mrs. Twana R. Purifoy Anderson, Mrs. Yadira Chavez, Mrs. Katy H. Richardson, Ms. Katrina L. Wright, and Mr. Richard W. Wingate. Visitors present (not all inclusive): Joey Brannan, Susan Webb, Emily Jackson, Holly Mitchell, Alicia Lyles, Zane Johnson, Brandon Kiser, James Bailey, Mitzi Clayton, Stephanie Douglas, Jan Bowen, Angie Ellis, Laura Stewart, Tina Richards, and Roshanda Lewis.

The notice of this meeting was posted on the public bulletin board in the central office on June 24, 2021. A reminder was sent electronically on May 10, 2022 and May 13, 2022 to a list of people who request board meeting information.

1. Mr. Richard W. Wingate called the meeting to order at 5:31 p.m. A quorum was established with all members present. Mrs. Yadira Chavez moved for the board to approve the agenda as presented, and Ms. Katrina L. Wright seconded the motion. Motion was approved with a unanimous vote. Voting was as follows: “AYE” – Anderson, Chavez, Richardson, Wingate, and Wright. “NAY” – None.
2. Delegations/Awards: The Superintendent recognized enior at Eufaula High School students who scored 30 or higher on the ACT; and honor band students. Winning artwork from Music and Arts in Our Schools was on display.
3. Mr. Richard W. Wingate called for the approval of the minutes from the February 15, 2022 and February 24, 2022 board meetings. Mrs. Katy H. Richardson moved that the minutes be approved and Mrs. Twana R. Purifoy Anderson seconded the motion. Motion was approved with a unanimous vote. Voting was as follows: “AYE” – Anderson, Chavez, Richardson, Wingate, and Wright. “NAY” – None.
4. Superintendent’s Report: The board received a monthly report from Public Relations. Holly Mitchell reviewed the revised grading categories for Eufaula Primary School. The changes will be included in the 2022-2023 Student/Parent Handbook.
5. Financial Statements and Bank Reconciliations: The March 2022 financial report for the system was reviewed and discussed. 48.84% of revenues have been collected, and 36.39% of the budget has been expended. The financial statement presented included all reconciled bank accounts for the Eufaula City Board of Education as of March 31, 2022. The Board was notified of this from Chief Financial Officer by statement noted on the Financial Report.
6. New Business:
 - A. Election of Board President and Vice-President: Ms. Katrina L. Wright made a motion for Mrs. Yadira Chavez to serve as president. Mrs. Katy H. Richardson seconded the motion. Motion was approved with a unanimous vote. Voting was

as follows: “AYE” – Anderson, Chavez, Richardson, Wright, and Wingate. “NAY” – None. Mrs. Twana R. Purifoy Anderson made a motion Mrs. Caty H. Richardson to serve as vice-president. Mrs. Yadira Chavez seconded the motion. Motion was approved with a unanimous vote. Voting was as follows: “AYE” – Anderson, Chavez, Richardson, Wright, and Wingate. “NAY” – None.

- B. Board Compensation: Mrs. Caty H. Richardson recommended that the members of the Eufaula City Board of Education forego compensation. Mrs. Yadira Chavez seconded the motion. Motion passed with a unanimous vote. Voting was as follows: “AYE” – Anderson, Chavez, Richardson, Wright, and Wingate. “NAY” – None.
- C. 2022-2023 Code of Conduct/Student Handbook, First Reading: The Superintendent recommended the board review the changes to the 2022-2023 Code of Conduct/Student/Parent Handbook and approve at the next board meeting. Ms. Katrina L. Wright moved to table the approval until the next board meeting and Mrs. Yadira Chavez seconded the motion. Motion passed with a unanimous vote. Voting was as follows: “AYE” – Anderson, Chavez, Richardson, Wright, and Wingate. “NAY” – None.
- D. 2022-2023 Employee Handbook, First Reading: The Superintendent recommended the board review the changes to the 2022-2023 Employee Handbook and approve at the next board meeting. Mrs. Caty H. Richardson moved to table the approval until the next board meeting and Mrs. Twana R. Purifoy Anderson seconded the motion. Motion passed with a unanimous vote. Voting was as follows: “AYE” – Anderson, Chavez, Richardson, Wright, and Wingate. “NAY” – None.
- E. Brenda Sikes M.Ed., CTVI Vision Services: The Superintendent recommended the board approve two contracts with Brenda Sikes, one for 2022 summer services and one for the 2022-2023 school year. We currently have three students who use braille and benefit from the services provided. Mrs. Yadira Chavez moved to accept the recommendation as presented. Ms. Katrina L. Wright seconded the motion. Motion passed with a unanimous vote. Voting was as follows: “AYE” – Anderson, Chavez, Richardson, Wright, and Wingate. “NAY” – None.
- F. Student Activities: The Superintendent recommended the board approve the following student activities:
- Eufaula High School Cheer: The Superintendent recommended the board contribute \$1,500 towards the purchase of a male uniform and “fill-in” uniforms.
 - Eufaula High School Esports Team: The Superintendent recommended the board provide \$2,400 in start-up funds to cover the unlimited access for the 2022-2023 gaming season.

- Eufaula High School Fees: The Superintendent recommended the board waive the \$96 AP Chemistry exam student fee for 25 students for a total cost of \$2,400 for the 2021-2022 school year.
- Eufaula High School Bass Team: The Superintendent recommended the board approve \$2,000 to assist with the cost of lodging and meals for the state tournament.
- Eufaula High School Activities: The Superintendent recommended the board approve student activities and fundraisers for Eufaula High School and Admiral Moorer Middle School.

Ms. Katrina L. Wright moved to approve the student activities recommendation of the Superintendent as presented. Mrs. Twana R. Purifoy Anderson seconded the motion. Motion passed with a unanimous vote. Voting was as follows: "AYE" – Anderson, Chavez, Richardson, Wingate, and Wright. "NAY" – None.

- G. Bank Change: The Superintendent recommended the board approve moving the Accounts Payable and Payroll accounts to MidSouth Bank and move the Eufaula High School account to Ameris Bank. Mrs. Ellis explained why she would like to make the change and how it would benefit Eufaula City Schools. Mrs. Twana R. Purifoy Anderson moved to accept the recommendation as presented. Mrs. Yadira Chavez seconded the motion. Motion passed with a unanimous vote. Voting was as follows: "AYE" – Anderson, Chavez, Richardson, Wright, and Wingate. "NAY" – None.
