GoGuardian Beacon

Scarborough Public Schools has adopted GoGuardian Beacon services as part of our school's broader suicide prevention program. GoGuardian Beacon is a monitoring software used on



school issued devices. It now has a parent / guardian notification feature for parents to get instant alerts if their child's online activity raises concerns on school issued devices. The alert will be sent to the email address listed in PowerSchool for the child's parents. The GoGuardian Beacon parent notifications will start during the week of January 6th.

GoGuardian Beacon helps notify our schools and parents if the system detects that a child searches, creates, views, or interacts with online content that could be related to suicide and active planning. Because of this, GoGuardian Beacon helps us detect and intervene when a child may be at risk of suicide or self-harm. If you get a notification, please talk with your child and check their online activity. If you feel you and your child need additional supports, please see the link below for resources and/or contact your health care provider / emergency services.

It is important to know that neither Scarborough Public Schools nor GoGuardian Beacon can possibly detect every situation when a child is suicidal. <u>Click here</u> for more information about GoGuardian/Beacon services and suicide prevention information.

Our Citizen-Led School Building Advisory Committee (SBAC) work is ramping up as we work toward selecting a school building proposal to go to voters in 2025!

Your input will directly inform which options the SBAC moves forward with as we work toward a final option to go to referendum. Here's how you can participate:

- Attend Community Forum #1: January 21st 6-8PM at Scarborough Middle School Cafeteria
 - Learn about the Four Options being considered for a school construction project to address Scarborough's needs, ask questions, and provide feedback.

- Take our community survey on the 4 options: Late January/Early February
 - The survey will be released in late January, following Community Forum #1. More detail on this to come in the new year!
 - The SBAC will take the community's feedback under advisement as they evaluate and reduce from 4 options to 2.

Here's what happened in December:

- Harriman Architects & Engineers was selected to work with the citizen-led SBAC2.
- Harriman's team has been deep in data collection mode, visiting and assessing the existing schools, reviewing previous reports, meeting with leadership, and working closely with the SBAC2 to dig into the four options identified by the SBAC2.
- Communication and Site Selection subcommittees of the SBAC2 kicked off their work.


