# **WANDO HIGH SCHOOL** ATTENDANCE POLICIES

#### ATTENDANCE FORM

Please use this form for all absences. If it is a medical absence, a doctor's note must be attached.



The form can also be found on our website under the "Parents & Students" tab and printed in our Attendance Offices.

#### PARENT NOTES

Students are permitted FIVE excused parent notes per semester. After a student has reached the allotted amount of excused parent notes, we will code absences (unless they are medical, legal, bereavement, etc.) as unexcused parent notes, which could potentially require seat time make-up for course credit.

#### **EARLY DISMISSALS**

If you are picking up your child from school for an early dismissal, you must present an ID and sign them out in our front attendance office. We encourage students to bring their note into the main attendance office before school to obtain a pass that will excuse them from class a few minutes prior to your arrival. This saves time if we do not need to call into their classroom to retrieve them. **No early** dismissals are permitted after 3:00PM.

## **TRUANCY**

A student ages 6 to 17 years meets the definition of a truant when the student has three consecutive unexcused absences or a total of five unexcused absences. You will be contacted to attend a truancy meeting to establish an attendance intervention plan to support your child.

## **TIMELINE**

The Wando Attendance form must be submitted within THREE school days of an absence to get it excused.

**COL -** College Visit (juniors & seniors)

## **SEAT TIME**

Students who accumulate more than 10 unexcused absences in a semester class or 15 in a yearlong class will be required to make up their seat time in order to pass the course. If they fail to do so, they will receive a **FA** (failure due to attendance) for the class. We will monitor attendance each semester and an administrator will meet with students who qualify for seat time.
