Program Description:

In this Teaching and Learning with Technology certificate, teachers will take a total of 5 courses. The purpose is to create expert educators who fully understand how to leverage technology to empower all learners and integrate STEAM pedagogy and instructional practice into educational environments.

- ◆ 5 courses for a total of 15 graduate credits
- ◆ Complete the AGC in less than a year
- ◆ A teacher friendly schedule that accommodates the K-12 school calendar
- ◆ Significant discount on standard University tuition (~\$900 savings per 3 credit course)
- ◆ Students earn the same graduate credit and have access to the same University services and privileges as their on-campus counterparts.
- ◆ This program has components of educating ELL students, which can satisfy the ELL required hours for NYS certification.
