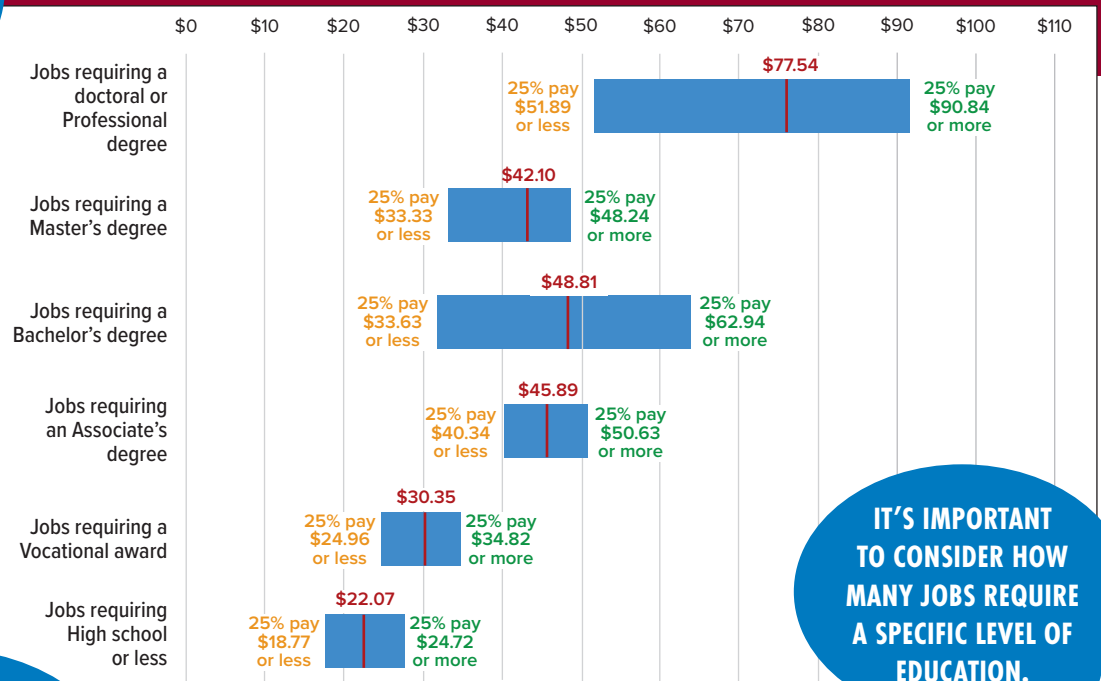
200 ELECTIVE CHOICES ACROSS ALL DEPARTMENTS

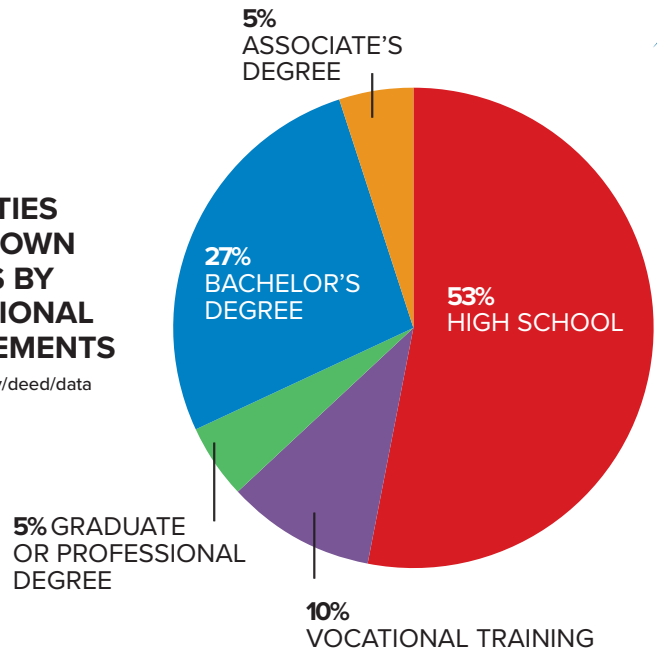

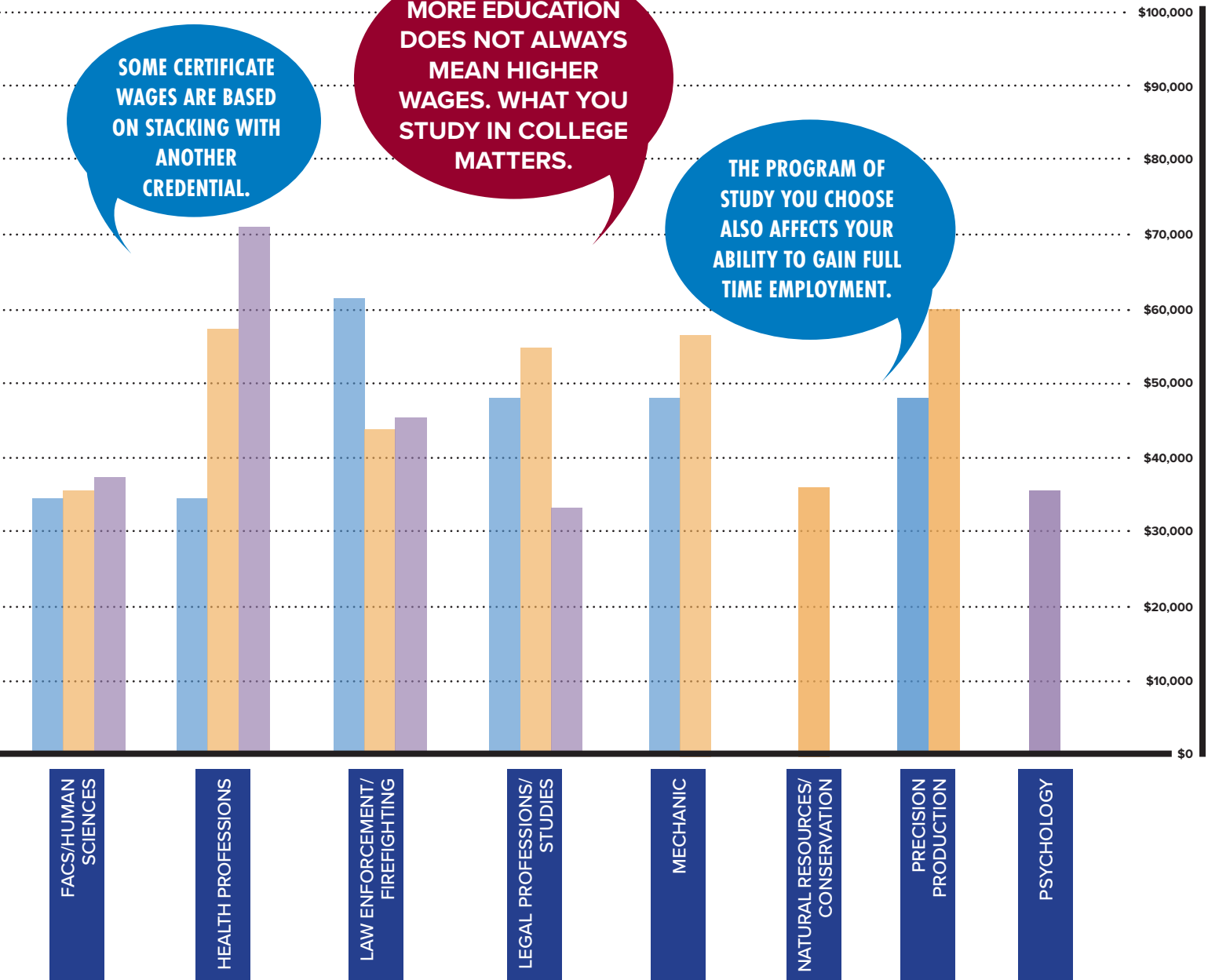
