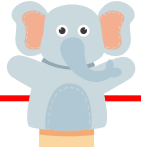

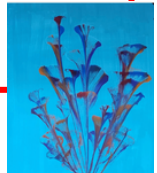
FLUID PAINTING – CHAIN PULL ART

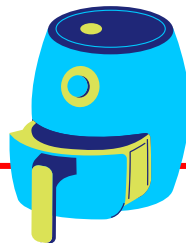
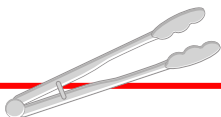
