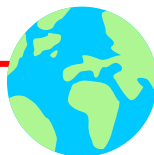


ELEMENTARY CODING & STEM CLUB WITH CSGA

MEGA POTATO PARTY CAMP ★

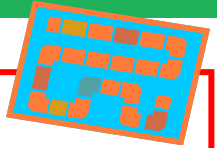
