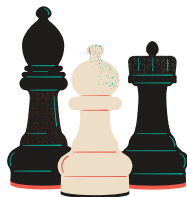
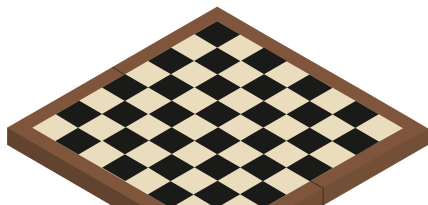
ELEMENTARY CHESS CLUB WITH CSGA

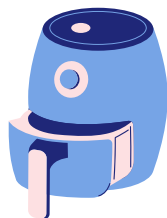

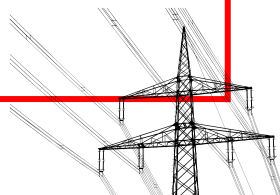

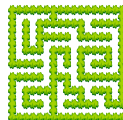
