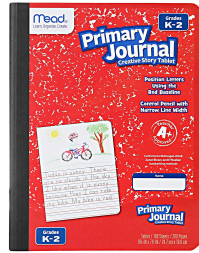


HUTH ROAD ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

2024-2025 Supply Lists

SECOND GRADE

- 2 boxes of 24 crayons
- 3 dozen **sharpened** yellow #2 pencils
- 1 box 12-colored pencils
- 1 Primary Journal:
 - ½ page drawing, ½ page lined
- 1 highlighter
- 2 black, Flair-tip markers
- 2 large pink or white erasers
- 1 pair of scissors, pointed 5"
- 10 glue sticks (.28 oz.)
- 1 plastic pencil/crayon box
- 1 spiral notebook (70 ct – wide ruled)
- 1 **sturdy** 2-pocket folder (to be used as a take-home folder)
- 5 **sturdy** 2-pocket folders w/prongs 1 each: red, yellow green, blue, purple
- 2 large box of tissues
- 1 set computer headphones (earbuds not recommended)
- 1 protective smock for art (a large, old shirt works well; **please label with your child's name**)
- 1 container of disinfecting wipes, baby wipes, or hand sanitizer
- 6 dry erase markers (black preferred)
- 1 dry eraser (a sock or small cloth works well)
- 2 packs of 3x3 Post-it® notes
- Optional Supplies** that can be used, but are not necessary: pack of washable markers, & liquid glue



THIRD GRADE

- 1 box 24 crayons (Crayola® preferred)
- 2 dozen **sharpened** yellow #2 pencils (*Dixon Ticonderoga* preferred)
- 2 highlighters
- 2 large pink or white erasers
- 1 plastic pencil/crayon box
- 1 pair of scissors, pointed 5"
- 10 glue sticks (Elmers preferred,.28 oz only)
- 2 marble composition notebooks
- 6 plain 2-pocket folders (1 each: red, orange, yellow, green, blue, purple)
- 1 sturdy take-home folder w/2 pockets
- 2 large boxes of tissues
- 1 container of Clorox®/Lysol® wipes
- 1 bottle of **small pump** hand sanitizer (8 oz.)
- 1 clipboard
- 1 set computer earbuds or headphones
- 2 dry erase markers (**chisel tip**, any color)
- 1 dry eraser (a wash cloth or fabric scrap works well)
- 1 protective smock for art (a large, old shirt works well)
- 1 water bottle (reusable or returnable)

*Please keep in mind that some supplies will need to be replenished through the course of the school year.
You may want to stock up in the summer while prices are lower.*

FOURTH GRADE

- 2 dozen **sharpened** yellow #2 pencils (*Dixon Ticonderoga* preferred)
- 1 box of 24 colored pencils (**sharpened**)
- 4 pens: 2 red, 2 blue or black (medium point)
- 2 highlighters, each a different color (*your choice*)
- 1 large pink or white eraser (opt.)
- 1 pair of scissors (that fits your child's hand)
- 4 small glue sticks
- 2 dry erase markers
- 1 dry eraser (a sock or small cloth works well)
- 1 12" ruler (cm & inches)
- 1 hand held pencil sharpener
- 1 pencil case or box (large enough to hold all writing utensils)
- 1 pkg. loose leaf paper (wide ruled)
- 2 marble composition notebooks
- 6 plain, 2-pocket folders (1 red, 1 yellow, 1 green, 1 orange, 1 purple, 1 blue)
- 1 heavy-duty pocket-folder for take home papers
- 1 container of Clorox®/Lysol® wipes, OR baby wipes OR pump hand sanitizer (*your choice*)
- 1 set computer earbuds or headphones (not wireless)
- 2 large boxes of tissues
- 1 protective smock for art (a large, old shirt works well)

FIFTH GRADE

- 4 Expo® dry erase markers (**chisel** tip, low odor)
- 4 Expo® dry erase markers (**fine** tip, low odor)
- 2 dozen **sharpened** yellow #2 pencils (*Dixon Ticonderoga* preferred)
- 1 box of 24 colored Crayola pencils
- 1 red pen (medium point)
- 1 black Sharpie®
- 1 large pink eraser
- 2 highlighters, any color
- 1 pair of scissors, pointed, 5"
- 4 glue sticks, large (1.27 oz.)
- 1 12" ruler (cm & inches)
- 1 pencil bag/ box
- 2 pkgs. loose leaf paper (wide ruled)
- 1 marble composition notebook
- 6 plain, 2-pocket folders (1 each: red, orange, yellow, green, blue, purple)
- 1 **heavy-duty** folder for take home papers
- 2 large boxes of tissues
- 1 dry eraser (white board eraser)
- 1 container of Clorox®/Lysol® wipes (Boys)
- 1 box of Zip-Top sandwich bags (Girls)
- 1 set computer earbuds or headphones w/microphone (NOT bluetooth/wireless)
- 1 protective smock for art (a large, old shirt works well)

PHYSICAL EDUCATION: All students need **sneakers** for every class (tie and Velcro® are best). A **sweatshirt** (to be left in their classroom lockers) is best for spring and fall when we go outside. Deodorant should be applied in the morning at home. Please leave jewelry at home on gym days.
