On October 16, 2024, the Holland Central School District will hold a public vote on a proposed Capital Improvement Project. This \$12.75 million initiative aims to address aging infrastructure and upgrade facilities to support our evolving educational programs. Prioritized by the Board of Education, these improvements are crucial and timely.

The 2024 Capital Improvement Project focuses on essential repairs and enhancements at the HCS D campus, ensuring the safety of our buildings and enriching our educational environment. These needs have been identified using the 2020 New York State Building Condition Survey and a comprehensive long-term facilities plan. 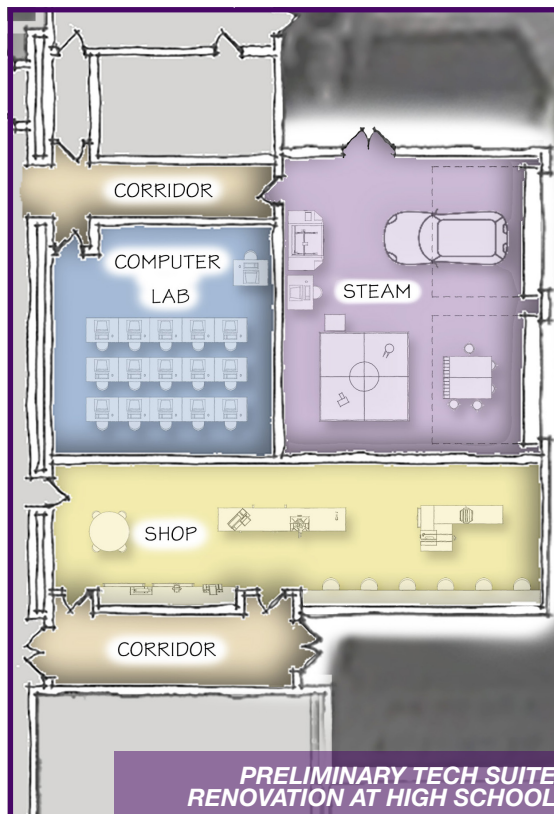

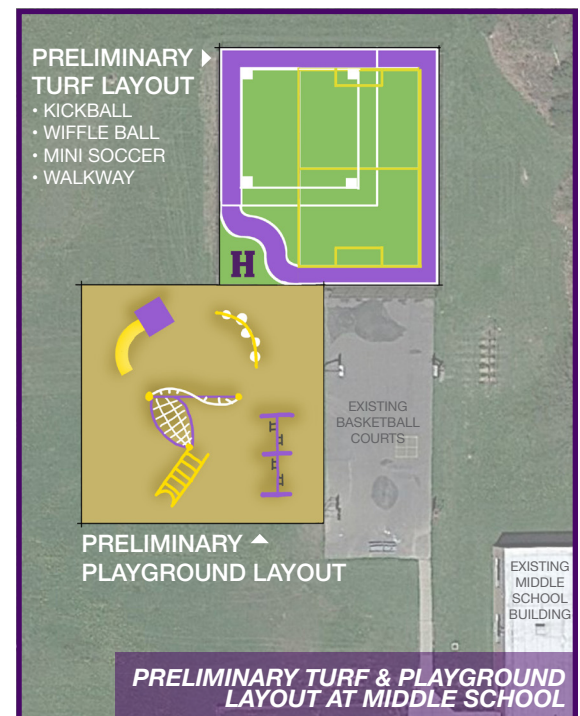
