### Description of the School

Warren East High School is a rural school that serves the northern portion of Warren County Kentucky. Warren County had over 139,000 residents and had an unemployment rate of 3.9% in 2023. WEHS is a Title I school that strives to meet the various needs within our community. WEHS has 977 students and 58 teachers. The students and faculty are supported by three guidance counselors, a school psychologist, two assistant principals, a dean of students, an interventionist, a building assessment coordinator, an instructional coach, a curriculum coordinator, a media specialist, a youth services center (YSC) coordinator, and an assistant YSC coordinator.

WEHS is in an area anticipated to experience future growth due to new manufacturing employment opportunities. In order to prepare our students for this growth, our students participate in various career shadow experiences, clubs, sports, and/or school-sponsored extracurricular activities intended to support the whole child. WEHS's Title 1 status provides access to other tools that provide students (over half of whom qualify for free and/or reduced lunch) with access to the resources needed to excel academically and socially.

The race and ethnicity of our school population were as follows: 1% Asian 10% Black/African American, 13% Hispanic/Latino, less than 1% American Indigenous or Alaska Native, less than 1% Native Hawaiian or Other Pacific Islander, almost 7% two or more races, and 69% White.

### School Stakeholders

Our stakeholders include the Bowling Green Chamber of Commerce, area industries, area post-secondary institutions, parents, students, and area educators. To ensure involvement and engagement we provide space for stakeholder voice during regularly scheduled SBDM meetings. We also provide students with opportunities to engage with each other and the community at-large via various clubs, organizations, and sports. We utilize our College and Career Readiness program to make sure that faculty and students are connected to area industries via job shadow opportunities, industry tours, and college visits. The students have opportunities to obtain industry certification and college credit for courses they take while at WEHS.

The mission of Warren East High School is to create a safe and orderly learning environment and provide students with a balance of knowledge, skills, and experiences that will enable them to reach their maximum potential and become ethical, responsible, and productive citizens.

WEHS focuses on providing supports for the whole student. Those supports include:

- Embedded social and emotion supports which occur via trauma Informed classroom practices and during weekly focused guidance;
- Ongoing behavior supports such as PBIS;
- Individualized academic supports through an intervention and enrichment period, utilization of students ILPs, incorporating high quality instructional materials, use of a viable curriculum, and an emphasis on cooperative learning;
- Intentional post-secondary solution supports via students ILPs and requested job shadows and career exploration.

We partner with the local community to build bridges that lead to student success. We ensure the psychological safety of students by fostering positive relationships between the school and the families we serve, and ensure the physical safety of our students by keeping our facilities in working condition while building positive relationships between students and teachers and among the student body.

## Notable Achievements and Areas of Improvement

Our notable achievements are as follows:

### **Academic Achievements**

- Post-secondary readiness for the class of 2023 was 92.5%, up from 79% for CO 2022. Last year's exceptional education seniors graduated 86.7% Post-secondary ready, up from 56.5% in 2022.
- WEHS as a 98.6% graduation rate, and last year, 119 students committed to attending college, military, or have full time employment after high school.
- Students participated in 11 AP & Dual Credit Classes

- Students participated in a new biomedical pathway through Project Lead the Way
- Top 25% KSA Overall Indicator Score

### **Extracurricular Achievements**

- 17 Students placed in top three in Beta; there were six 1st place finishes.
- Educators Rising - Top 3 Finishes in State
- Kentucky PBIS Gold Status
- Percussion Ensemble - 2023 WGI Scholastic Concert World Champions
- 2023 2A Baseball State Champions
- Five District Championships - boys soccer, girls soccer, volleyball - 1st Ever

### **Social and Behavioral Achievements**

- Every Student has received at least one positive hand-written card from a teacher
- 714 Student have no behavior referrals, 81% 0-1 referrals
