- Academic/behavior reports will be sent home as needed.
- Report Cards will be sent home every nine weeks.
- State Assessment Reports will be sent home as the school receives them.

- Parents can contact teachers through their email or parent communication platform determined by the teacher.
- In addition, conferences may be scheduled before school, during teacher planning period, after school, or at other convenient times.

- Parents may schedule times to volunteer.
- Parents may make appointments to observe their child's class.

Ensure regular two-way, meaningful communication between family members and school staff, and, to the extent practicable, in language that family members can understand.
