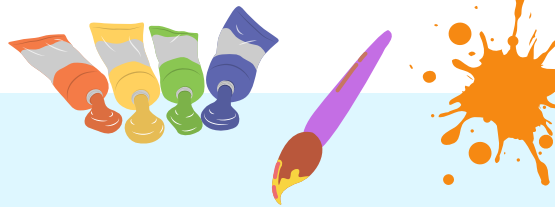
FAMILY PAINT NIGHT – SPRING BOUQUET
