







Helix defies the odds by closing the achievement gap for Black, Brown, and economically disadvantaged students.


2024 California Assessment of Student Performance and Progress (CAASPP)





Red Line = All Helix subgroups exceeded the highest subgroup in California


As a college prep school, our goal is to have ALL students experience success in college level curriculum and instruction so they are confident they can succeed in college if they choose to attend. We have developed a robust, blended Advanced Placement (AP) and Dual Enrollment (DE) Community College Program to support this effort. Last year we offered 76 DE courses with a pass rate of 99% and 23 AP courses with a test pass rate of 83%. The graph below shows the increased participation in this program over the past decades from a small, select group, to the inclusion of the majority of our students.


Helix Graduates and UC/CSU A-G Completers
