SCHOOL CHARACTERISTICS

Established in 1934, Laguna Beach High School (LBHS) has an enrollment of 817 students. It is the only high school within the Laguna Beach Unified School District and the smallest public high school in Orange County. LBHS offers a strong college-preparatory program, is recognized as a California Gold Ribbon School and California Distinguished School, and, in 2019, LBHS received a six-year accreditation from the Western Association of Schools and Colleges (WASC). Beyond its strong academic focus, LBHS has implemented the Learner Profile, an initiative developed collaboratively with educators, parents, community members, and students. This program focuses on developing essential skills such as teamwork, problem-solving, effective communication, resiliency, creativity, and empathy. These skills are foundational to success in both academic and professional life and as a contributing member of the community.

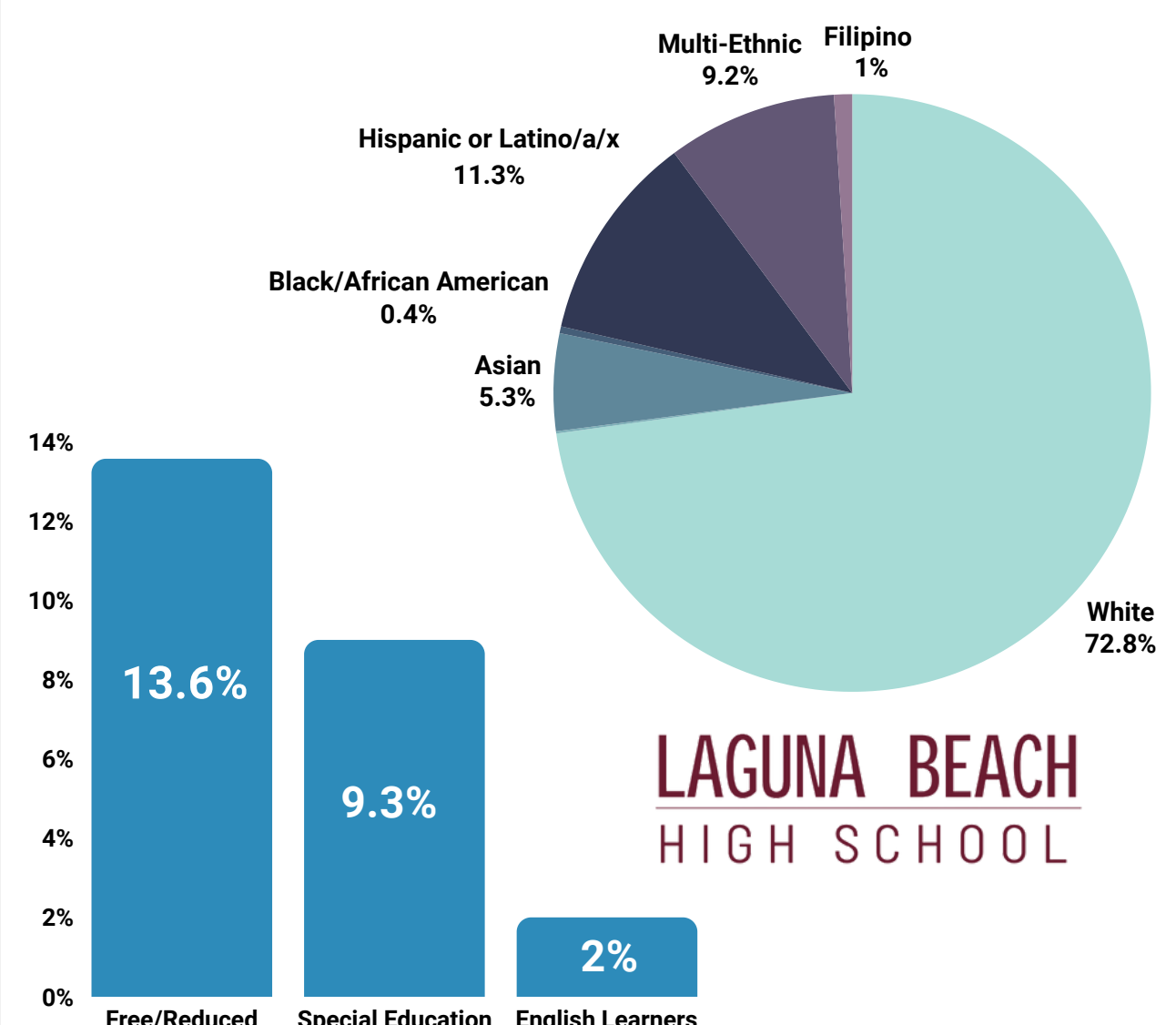
GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

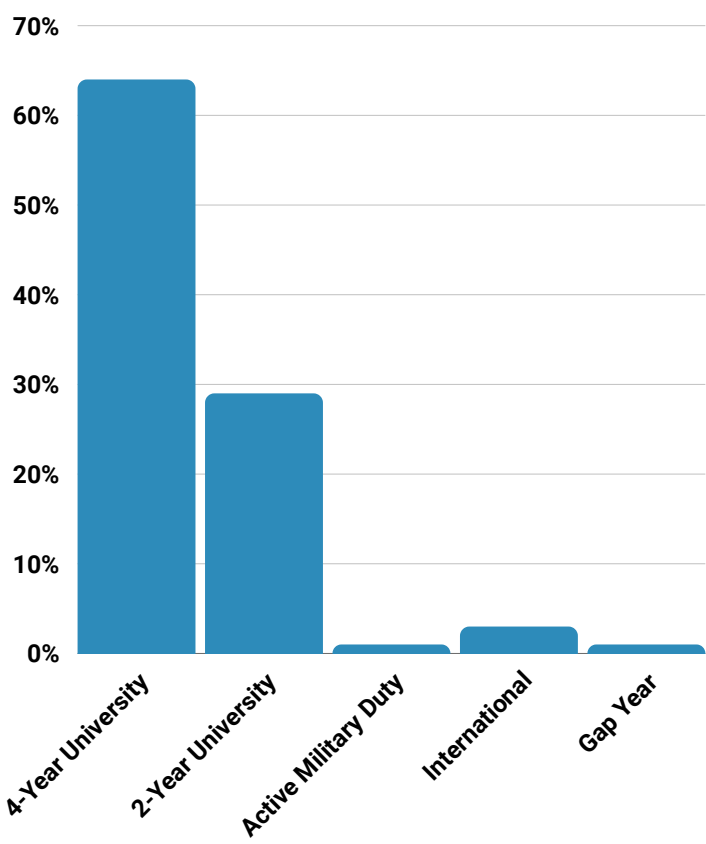
