NEW STUDENT FEES

All fees below are non-refundable.

TUITION

Tuition may be paid by one of three plans:

1. Yearly (Due July 1, 2025)

A continuous Enrollment Packet between parents and TKA is required/due for new students. This includes a tuition agreement along with payment of the enrollment fee (\$180 new student registration).

- All families are required to be enrolled in FACTS Management for tuition and incidental (non-tuition) fee accounting. Note all payments must be made through FACTS.
- **TKA has a Tuition Assistance program to help families for whom full tuition is not affordable. An online application is located on TKA's website under "Admissions".**

PAYMENT POLICIES

- Once a new student has been accepted, the registration fee and tuition desposit must be submitted within ten days.
- The first tuition payment is due by July 1, 2025 and is non-refundable. Tuition payments are due on the first of each month.
- A \$25 late fee is applied when tuition payments are not received by FACTS by the 10th of each month. A \$25 late fee is applied when any school fee is not received by its due date.
- Students may not be permitted to attend class if their tuition is more than 30 days late, unless prior arrangements have been made with the Business Office.

PAYMENT POLICIES *(continued)*

- Exceptions to any of the tuition and fee policies will be made by written agreement with the Business Office.
- **Please contact the Business Office if a problem arises that affects your ability to make a payment.**

FEEES FOR VOLUNTARY PROGRAMS

Academic and VPA Fees

Non-refundable fees apply for AP exams and summer school as well as for some Visual and Performing Arts (VPA) electives and extra-curricular programs.

Athletic Sports Fees

This non-refundable fee is due before the first league or “official” game, and is paid for each sport in which the student participates. Please see website (under “Admissions”) for details.

SERVICE TRIP FEES

TKA's annual Service Week provides high school students a missions experience of serving families and communities in need. Service opportunities within California cost \$900-\$1,000. Trips within the U.S. and to Mexico range from \$1,000-\$2,400, and international trips range from \$2,400-\$4,000. Students are encouraged to fundraise to cover the expense of these trips.
