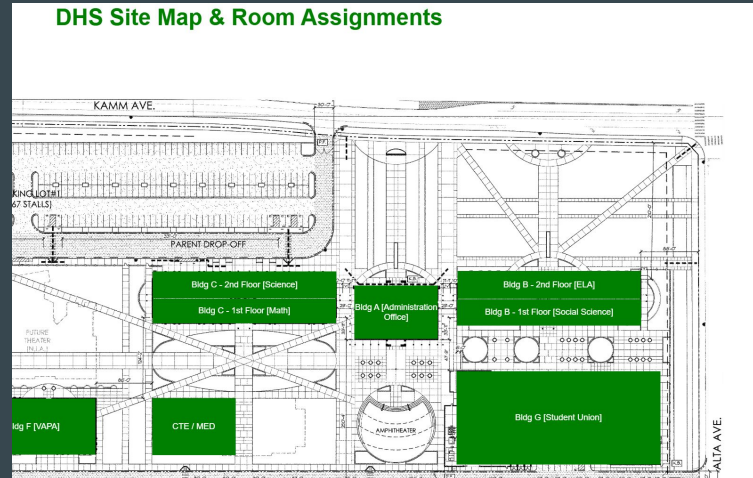

- Accessible to all students on their Chromebooks.



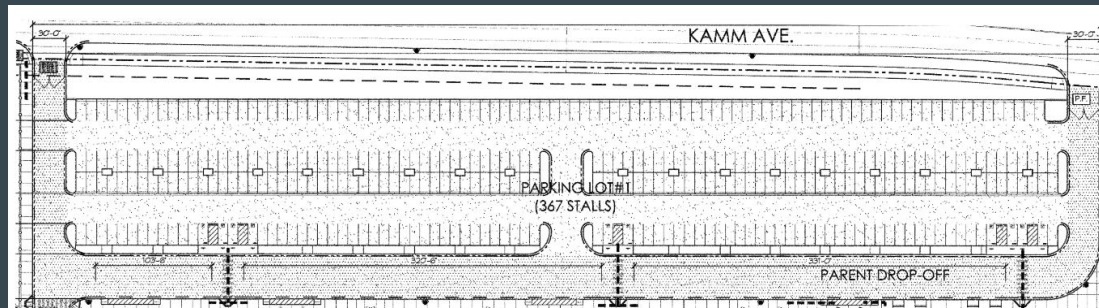
New Campus Policy Changes

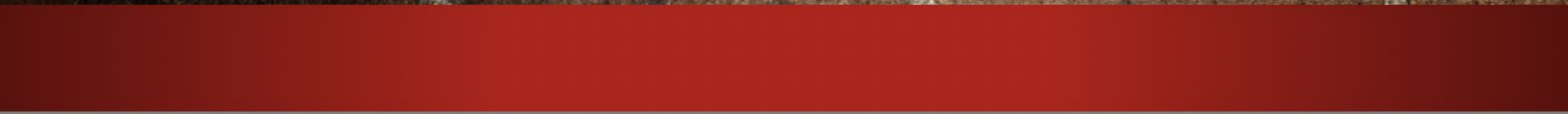
Student Parking

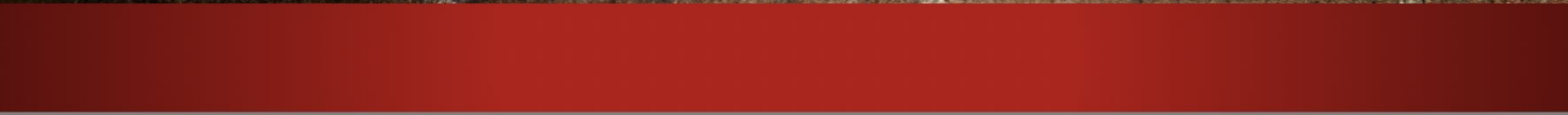

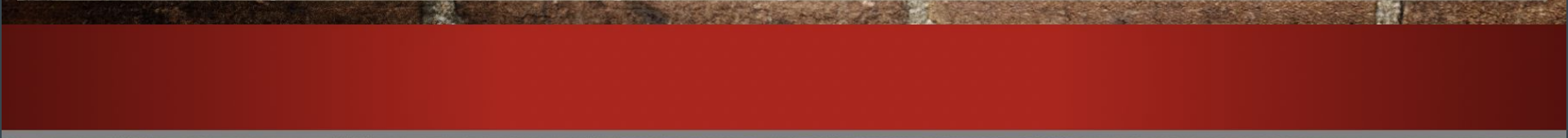
