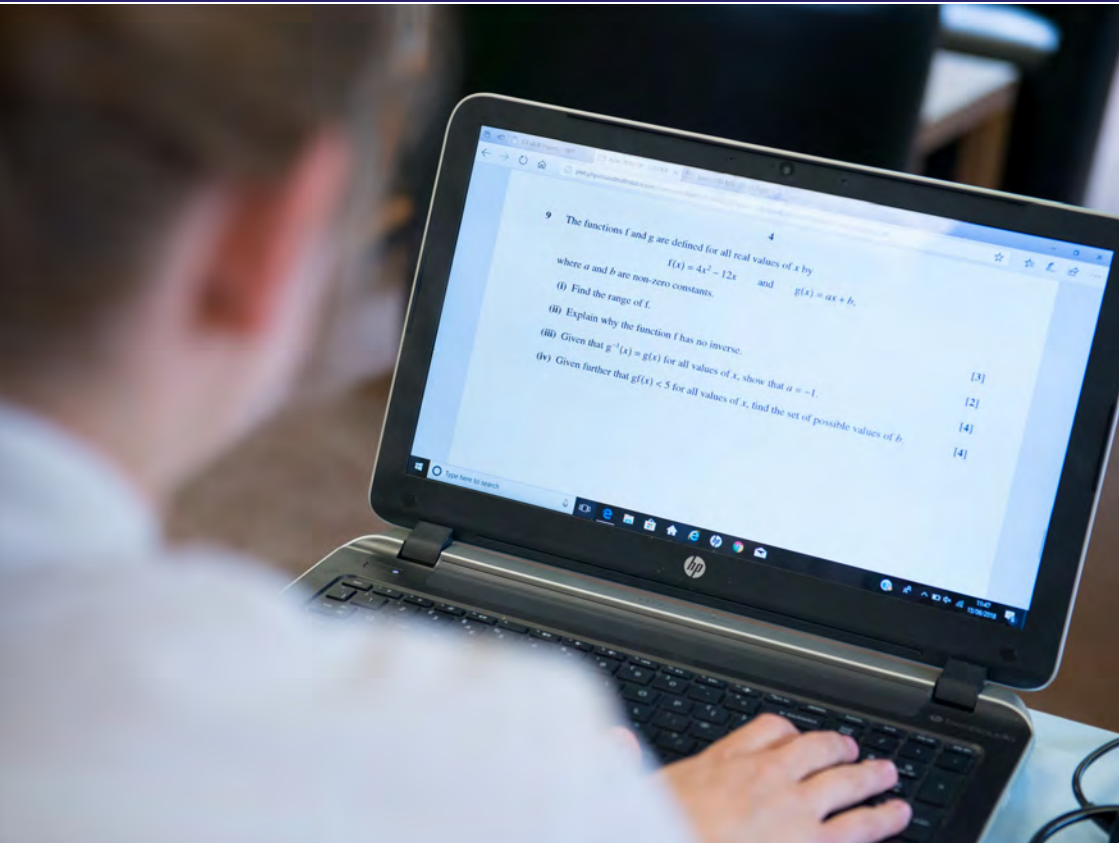

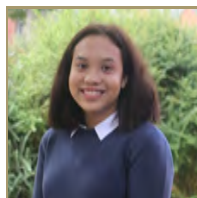


Amanda Bani
