STUDENT CHARGES (BORROWING/GRACE PERIOD)

Students may charge meals up to the value of two breakfasts and two lunches (\$9.50 for Junior High). An automated phone call occurs when a negative balance appears on a student's account. If a student account exhausts the grace period/charge limit, the student must select a peanut butter and jelly or toasted cheese sandwich entree for lunch and/or a cereal entrée for breakfast until the negative balance is paid. A la Carte items are not available for charging.

FREE/REDUCED-PRICE MEAL PROGRAM

We encourage you to complete the USDA free/reduced price meal application if you feel economic hardship exists. Applications expire each year and must be submitted each year.
