# **Tips for Test Day**

## Schedule/Change or cancel appointments at least 24 hours in advance

You must change or cancel your test at least 24 hours before your appointment time or else you will lose your payment. If you cancel your appointment with less than 24 hours notice or do not show up, you will not receive a refund. You must contact Pearson VUE GED Testing Service 24 hours (one full business day) prior to your scheduled appointment at 1-877-392-6433. Rescheduling less than 24 hours (one full business day) prior to your appointment will result in forfeiting your test fees. Pearson VUE hours of business are 7:00 am central time to 7:00pm central time, Monday through Friday.

#### Arrive early

Make sure you know where the testing center is and arrive at least 15 minutes prior to your scheduled GED test appointment. You will need to check in at the office when you get there. If you arrive more than 15 minutes after your scheduled appointment time, you may not be admitted and may lose your test fee. Please call your testing center if you believe you may be late or will not be able to make your appointment.

#### Know the test center rules

Cell phones are strictly forbidden in the testing room. If you are found with a cell phone during testing, you will be escorted out and your test will not be scored. You will also need to reschedule and pay for another test. Other personal items (such as cell phone, handbags, backpacks, wallets, keys, etc.) are not allowed in the testing room. Secure storage is available. You may access your personal items during scheduled breaks.

#### Where can I find my scores?

Scores are available the same day you test on your MyGED online portal under the My Scores section. Log in at <u>GED.com</u> to see your scores. You will receive an email when your scores are ready for viewing on MyGED.

### What do I need to bring to the testing center?

You will be required to provide one valid form of identification on the day of the test. The ID must be government-issued and non-expired. It must also include your name, address, date of birth, signature, and photograph. The following types of identification will be accepted:

- Passport
- Driver's license
- Learner's Permit
- National/State/Country Identification Card
- Any other form of government-issued ID (national or foreign)

Other personal items (such as cell phone, handbags, backpacks, wallets, keys, etc.) are not allowed in the testing room. Secured storage lockers are available. During scheduled breaks and lunches, you may access your personal items.
