2. [AI Summit Follow-Up:](#)

Chris Oliver, Terri Donovan, BSHistory teacher, Dr. Maguire plus a team of colleagues attended an AI Educational Summit at MIT which offered many workshops around the use and impact of AI in education. It is the hope that through partnering with MIT, educators will be ahead of the impact AI will have on education unlike the impact that social media did. K-12 educators will be able to learn how to teach students proper ways to use AI and for teachers to be able to use AI comfortably. MIT sees the value of AI being used in planning and grading and in doing so, giving time back to teachers to work with students. The tasks ahead for Bourne are to develop its AI policy and to educate staff and students.

Baseline data for goals is selected from the current performance data shared when developing the student profile. Accommodations and modifications are broken down. There is improved collaboration through shared responsibility.
