


VOLUNTEERS NEEDED!

STEPS TO BECOME A VOLUNTEER

LEVEL 1

• ALL Parents/Guardians of Active HUSD students



All parents and legal guardians of current/active HUSD students are welcome to volunteer. Fingerprint clearance is not required for parents/guardians unless they will be chaperoning a field trip or working with students one-on-one (i.e., student tutoring or coaching)



Coordinate or make arrangements with your school's staff to volunteer. Check-in and register through the volunteer management system in the front office. A picture and other necessary information will be captured.

LEVEL 2

- Parents/Guardians who wish to go on Field Trips
- ALL Non-Parents
- Coaches



All non-parents are welcome to volunteer, but first must pass the background check and follow the steps below. Also, fingerprint clearance is required for parents/guardians who wish to chaperone a field trip or work with students one-on-one (i.e., student tutoring or coaching)



Visit our website, under the Parents/Community heading click on Volunteer Opportunities. Once there click on the 'Online Volunteer Application' on the left side of the page. In the upper right corner you will see 'Apply for this Position', click that, fill out the form and submit.



Bring your fingerprint clearance card to the District office during business hours. If you don't have a clearance card already stop by the district office Monday-Friday 8:00am 3:00pm to have your fingerprints taken.



Sending fingerprints out can take up to 8 weeks for results, so please be sure to plan accordingly. Upon successful completion of both of the above items, you will be added to the official district wide volunteer approval list. You can then work with your specific school site directly to sign up for volunteer opportunities.

Thank you for your interest in sharing your gifts and talents with our staff and students.

Each site Administrator has the right to accept or refuse volunteers at any time and for any reason. While we don't anticipate this to happen often, there are instances when a volunteer can be a distraction to the learning environment.
