- YOU ARE A SENIOR! Make sure to work hard and finish strong!
- If you are an 18-year-old male, you are required by law to register with the Selective Service. A man who fails to register before turning age 26 could face a fine of up to \$250,000 and/or a prison term of up to five years. In addition to fines, male students who do not register will NOT qualify for federal student loans or grant programs. This also will impact individuals interested in working for the federal government.

- Visit the colleges you have decided to apply to. Getting a feel for the campus is important!
- Talk to college representatives from the schools who visit our school. Visit times vary. Be sure to listen carefully to afternoon announcements, check Naviance frequently, and stop by School Counseling for more information.
- Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). The application will open on October 1st.
- Complete and submit your applications. Writing a strong essay is also a key component to getting into the college of your choice.
- Take the SAT or the ACT again, if necessary. The colleges that interest you will list the testing requirements on their admissions information webpage!
- Keep an eye out for information about Bright Futures. The Office of School Counseling will monitor your eligibility and notify you if we need additional information.
- Attend your Senior appointment in School Counseling and submit all required graduation documents on time. Senior Plan Forms will be due on Friday, May 2, 2025.
