Post Secondary Enrollment Option (PSEO)

- PSEO is a program that allows 10th, 11th and 12th grade students to earn both high school and college credit while still in high school.

- 10th Grade on a limited basis
- 11th and 12th full-time or part-time basis

Reasons to do PSEO

- Take classes BHS does not offer
- Experience college-level courses
- Get started earning college credits before high school graduation
- Experience and explore college options

College Options at BHS

- Advanced Placement (AP)
 - College credit via test in May
- College in the Schools (CIS)
 - College credit via successful course completion
- Concurrent Enrollment
 - College credit via successful course completion
- AA Degree Program
 - Determine interest during 10th grade year.

Earning your BHS diploma

- BHS credit requirements
- College classes will factor into GPA
- Team with your counselor to stay on track

Transferring College Credits

- Communicate with college admissions officers to ensure credits transfer
- Private colleges have their own rules
- MN Transfer Curriculum will transfer to U of M and MNSCU

- Some colleges offer virtual courses (synchronous or asynchronous)
- Visit the campus
- Many classes are online, consider transportation

- 3.0 for 11th Grade
- 2.5 for 12th Grade
