


Special Education Monthly Board Report Emmett School District December, 2024

Special Education Demographics:

 As of December 11, 2024, the home page of our IEP platform (Edplan) shows 361 students receiving Special Education with an additional 9 Referrals, and 18 Consents for Evaluation.
