Purpose of Team	The Bond Advisory Team will provide input for implementing projects funded by the recently passed bond for Cheney Public Schools. The team will support transparency, accountability, and the effective use of bond funds to meet the District's capital improvement needs.
Scope of Team	<p><i>The Bond Advisory Team will:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Review and advise on bond-funded projects.• Monitor project progress and budget expenditures.• Assist in communicating bond project updates to the community.• Align projects with the District's long-term facilities plan. <p><i>The Team's scope specifically excludes:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Making decisions, such as project designs, budgets, or contractors.• Negotiating contracts or managing day-to-day project operations.• Approving change orders or making budgetary adjustments.• Meeting or corresponding with contractors, subcontractors, or agents.
Goals or Objectives	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Align bond project execution with the District's educational goals.• Maximize the impact of bond funds on improving school facilities.• Support processes that reflect the District's commitment to safe and effective learning environments.• Maintain transparency and accountability in bond fund utilization.• All members will be independent without any professional or personal relationships to the District or related to the bond program work, i.e. conflict of interest.
Team Members	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Bond Project Manager - Turner & Townsend, Heery: Oversees daily management and progress of projects.• Superintendent: Leadership and alignment with the District's goals.• Finance Director: Fiscal accountability and alignment with the bond budget.• Director of Maintenance & Operations: Feasibility and sustainability of projects.• Parent/Guardian Representatives: Community insight and advocacy.• Student Representative: Shares the perspective of students.• School Board Member(s) Up to 2: Liaison(s) to the School Board.• Communications Coordinator: Community engagement and information sharing.
