Job responsibilities:

1. Planning, assessing, and reporting student progress.
2. Collaboration in professional learning communities (PLC) regularly with department teachers and grade level teachers monthly.
3. Attend professional development both in school and within the region.
4. Fulfill additional duties which include lunch/recess supervision, homeroom mentoring, and study hall supervision.
5. Utilize digital tools to transform instruction and support student learning.
6. Support inquiry-based and project-based learning strategies.
7. Supervise/Assist/Resource for Bible teachers at all levels.
8. Serve as a resource for faith connections in all academic areas (e.g., MYP/DP biblical worldview integration)

Other job responsibilities include:

1. Collaborate with the Special Needs Coordinator, EAL Coordinator, and other student support service leaders to provide students with successful academic support.
