# Budget Development Timeline Key Dates to Remember

- January 15<sup>th</sup> Governor's Budget First Look
- February 19<sup>th</sup> Board Approval of the Tax Cap
- March 1<sup>st</sup> Submission of Tax Cap Due to OCS
- March 19<sup>th</sup> Approval of Voter Propositions
- April 1<sup>st</sup> Governor's Budget Due
- April 21<sup>st</sup> BOE Candidate Petitions Due by 5:00pm
- April 22<sup>nd</sup> Board adopts the budget and Property Tax Report Card
- May 7<sup>th</sup> Public Hearing
- May 20<sup>th</sup> Budget Vote
- May 21<sup>st</sup> Ratify Election Results
