





ATHLETIC FACILITY IMPROVEMENTS:

New stadium at Snider High School to host varsity and junior varsity football, track, soccer and marching band events

- Construction of 4,400 seat stadium and pressbox
- Construction of vented rubber running track and synthetic turf
- Construction of additional parking
- Expansion of existing physical education building
- Construction of new concession and restroom building
- Relocation of tennis courts to Lane Middle School
- Construction of Track Storage Building
- Construction of practice soccer field at Long Road for Snider Boys/Girls soccer




- •Spring '25- Girls tennis will still occur on the existing courts at Snider
- •Spring '25-Construction of new tennis courts and parking lot at Lane
- •Spring '25- Work on the Snider side of campus will begin after the Girls tennis season and Spring Track seasons
- •March 10, 2025- Board Approval for remaining work
- •Fall '25- Boys tennis to use new courts at Lane. Parking for this and the Girls Spring '26 season will need to use other Lane / Snider parking (new parking lot will be used for contractor staging)
- •Summer/Fall '25- Football will still utilize practice field and PE building; Freshman and J/V Football will host "home" games offsite (undetermined at this time)
- •Spring '26- Boys and Girls Track will utilize offsite practice facility as well host "home" meets offsite (undetermined at this time)
- •Summer '26- Reed Road Improvements and move crosswalk light to new location
- •Fall '26- Stadium opens for inaugural Snider Home Football <u>AND</u> Soccer Seasons



Construction Impacts

- South parking lot exit restricted Summer 2025, 2026
- Reed Road traffic restrictions Summer 2026





Game Day Traffic Control

- FWCS is currently working with FWPD on a traffic control plan
- Relocation of pedestrian crosswalk
- Increased parking capacity from 751 spots to 921 across multiple locations
