World Language courses

- World Language is recommended for 9th grade students.
- Two years (2.0 credits) of world language is required for graduation. Some colleges require 3 years (3.0 credits) of world language.
- If you are bilingual or proficient in another language, you have the option of taking a World Language Proficiency test to earn credits.
- Students are tested in speaking, listening, writing, and reading.
