What are some things shaped like triangles? Some rulers are shaped like triangles. Some road signs are shaped like triangles, too!



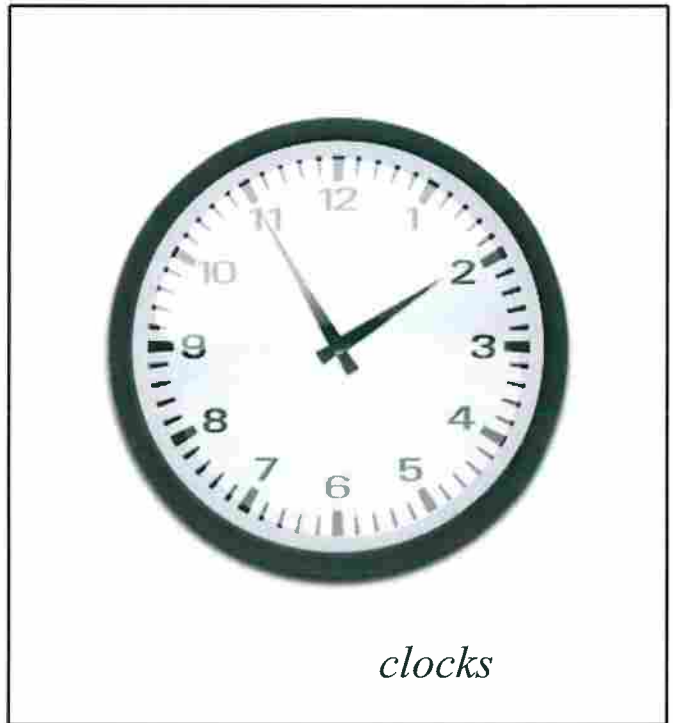
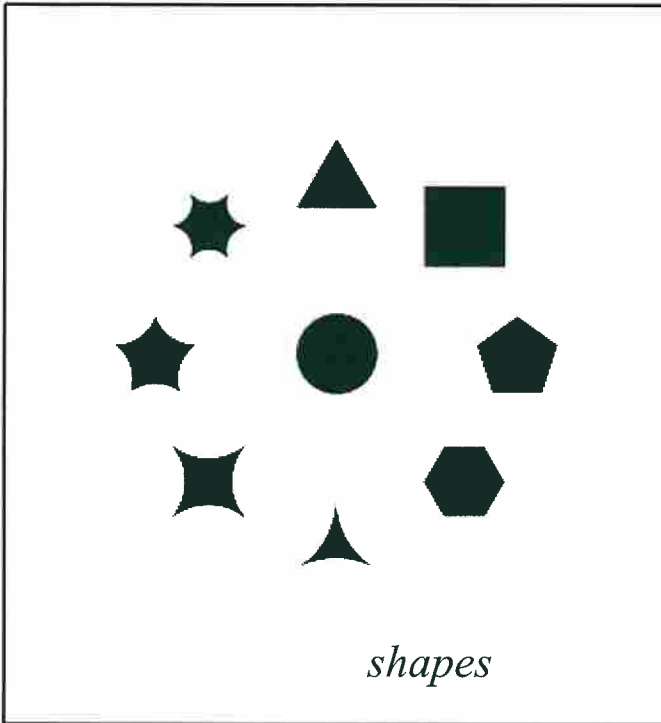
