

- 1. Applicant must be a legal resident of the United States.
- 2. Applicant must be a student in good standing at selected high schools.
- 3. Applicant must be a graduating high school senior during the school year of the award.
- 4. Applicant must be planning to attend an accredited institution of higher learning upon graduation from high school. Students planning to attend universities, colleges, seminaries, technical colleges and community colleges are all encouraged to apply.
- e) Applicants must be planning to enroll in a post-secondary program of study that will result in a bachelor's or associate degree, skilled trade certification or equivalent.


