<p><b>Reading:</b> Read a book at home and tell a family member what you read about.</p>	<p><b>Math:</b> Measure 5 items around your house using a ruler, paper clips, pennies, or another item.</p>	<p><b>Science:</b> Build a fort for an animal that is outside to give it shelter from the snow. It can be a drawing or using objects around your house.</p>
<p><b>Reading:</b> Find and write down 10 words that you find around your house? (on cereal boxes, the refrigerator, etc)</p>	<p><b>Math:</b> Create 5 Addition problems and solve them.</p>	<p><b>Science:</b> Melting snow activity. Fill a clear container full of packed snow. Place a ruler next to the container. Every 5-10 minutes check and record how much snow has melted.</p>
<p><b>Writing:</b> Write 2- 3 sentences about the fun that you had in the snow.</p>	<p><b>Math:</b> Count to 50 by 5's, then count to 100 by 10's.</p>	<p><b>Science:</b> Which melts snow faster? Fill two packed containers with snow. Add cold water to one and salt to the second one. Observe and determine which one melts quicker.</p>
<p><b>Writing:</b> Write the steps of how to build a snowman.</p>	<p><b>Math:</b> Create 5 subtraction problems and solve them.</p>	<p><b>Social Studies:</b> Think about what services do we provide in the community during a snowstorm? What workers are there? What are those workers doing?</p>

<p><b>Lectura:</b> Lee un libro en casa y cuéntale a un familiar lo que has leído.</p>	<p><b>Matemáticas:</b> Mide 5 objetos de tu casa con una regla, clips, monedas u otro objeto.</p>	<p><b>Ciencia:</b> Construye un fuerte para un animal que esté en el exterior para darle cobijo de la nieve. Puede ser un dibujo o utilizar objetos de tu casa.</p>
<p><b>Lectura:</b> Busca y escribe 10 palabras que encuentres por tu casa... (en las cajas de cereales, la nevera, etc.)</p>	<p><b>Matemáticas:</b> Crea 5 problemas de Suma y resuélvelos.</p>	<p><b>Ciencia:</b> Actividad para derretir la nieve. Llena un recipiente transparente con nieve compacta. Coloca una regla junto al recipiente. Cada 5-10 minutos comprueba y registra cuánta nieve se ha derretido.</p>
<p><b>Escritura:</b> Escribe 2 ó 3 frases sobre lo bien que te lo has pasado en la nieve.</p>	<p><b>Matemáticas:</b> Cuenta hasta 50 de 5 en 5, luego cuenta hasta 100 de 10 en 10.</p>	<p><b>Ciencia:</b> ¿Qué derrite la nieve más rápido? Llena dos recipientes llenos de nieve. Añade agua fría a uno y sal al segundo. Observa y determina cuál se derrite más rápido.</p>
<p><b>Escritura:</b> Escribe los pasos de cómo construir un muñeco de nieve.</p>	<p><b>Matemáticas:</b> Crea 5 problemas de resta y resuélvelos.</p>	<p><b>Estudios sociales:</b> Piensa en los servicios que se prestan en la comunidad durante una tormenta de nieve. ¿Qué trabajadores hay allí? ¿Qué hacen esos trabajadores?</p>
