It is understood that the District reserves the right to reject this bid and that the Bid shall remain open to acceptance and once opened, is irrevocable for a period of NINETY (90) days.

Site Visit Certification: By submission of this bid, the Bidder hereby certifies that its estimating and management staff has visited the site of the proposed work and is fully acquainted with the conditions relating to construction and labor. Bidder fully understands the facilities, difficulties, and restrictions pertaining to the execution of the work and has also relayed this information to all listed subcontractors and suppliers. Bidder fully indemnifies **BURBANK UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT** and all their respective officers, agents, employees, and consultants from any damage or omission related to conditions that could have been identified during a visit to the site.

The undersigned shall, within ten (10) business days after the delivering of a Notice of Award, execute and deliver an agreement in the form of agreement present in these Contract Documents and provide Performance and Payment Bonds in accordance with the specifications and bid as accepted.

The Bidder specifically acknowledges and understands that if it is awarded a Contract, that it shall perform the Work of the Project while fully cooperating and complying with all applicable provisions of the District's labor compliance program. The undersigned Bidder hereby certifies that Bidder can furnish labor that can work in harmony with all other elements of labor employed or to be employed on the Work.

Bidder expressly acknowledges that it is aware that if a false claim is knowingly submitted (as the terms "claims" and "knowingly" are defined in the California False Claims Act, CA Gov. Code, §2650 et. Seq.), the District will be entitled to civil remedies set forth in the California False Claims Act. It may also be considered fraud and the Contractor may be subject to criminal prosecution.

It is understood and agreed that if written notice of the acceptance of this bid is delivered to the undersigned after the opening of the bid, and within the time this bid is required to remain open, or at any time thereafter before this bid is withdrawn, the undersigned will execute and deliver to the District a contract in the form attached hereto in accordance with the bid as accepted, and that he will also furnish and deliver to the District TWO (2) executed original Payment Bond and Performance Bond as specified, all within TEN (10) days after receipt of Notice of Award letter, and that the work under the contract shall be commenced by the undersigned bidder, if awarded the contract, on the date to be stated in the District's "Notice To Proceed", and shall be completed by the Contractor in the time specified in the contract documents.

This insurance shall insure against all risks, including but not limited to the following perils: vandalism, theft, malicious mischief, fire, sprinkler leakage, civil authority, sonic boom, explosion, collapse, flood, earthquake (for projects not solely funded through revenue bonds, limited to earthquakes equivalent to or under 3.5 on the Richter Scale in magnitude), wind, hail, lightning, smoke, riot or civil commotion, debris removal (including demolition) and reasonable compensation for the Architect's services and expenses required as a result of such insured loss. This insurance shall provide coverage in an amount not less than the full cost to repair, replace or reconstruct the Work. Such insurance shall include the Owner and any other person or entity with an insurable interest in the Work as an additional named insured.

The Contractor shall submit to the Owner for its approval all items deemed to be uninsurable under the Builder's Risk/Course-of-Construction insurance. The risk of the damage to the Work due to the perils covered by the Builder's Risk/Course-of-Construction insurance, as well as any other hazard which might result in damage to the Work, is that of the Contractor and the surety, and no claims for such loss or damage shall be recognized by the Owner, nor will such loss or damage excuse the complete and satisfactory performance of the Contract by the Contractor.



BID FORM

NOTE: A bidder shall not submit a bid unless the bidder's contractor's license number appears clearly on the bid, the license expiration date and class are stated, and the bid contains a statement that the representations made therein are made under penalty of perjury. Any bid submitted by a contractor who is not licensed pursuant to Business and Professions Code §7028.15 shall be considered nonresponsive and shall be rejected. Any bid not containing the above information, or a bid containing information which is subsequently proven false, may be considered nonresponsive and may be rejected. Each bid must give the full business address of the bidder and be signed by bidder with bidder's usual signature. Bids by partnerships must furnish the full name of all partners and must be signed in the partnership name by a general partner with authority to bind the partnership in such matters, followed by the signature and designation of the person signing. Bids by corporations must be signed with the legal name of the corporation, followed by the name of the state of incorporation and by the signature and designation of the chairman of the board, president or any vice president, and then followed by a second signature by the secretary, assistant secretary, the chief financial officer or assistant treasurer. All persons signing must be authorized to bind the corporation in the matter. The name of each person signing shall also be typed or printed below the signature. Satisfactory evidence of the authority of the officer signing on behalf of a corporation shall be furnished.
