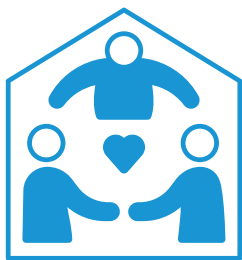


COMMITMENT TO STUDENT SAFETY AND FAMILY PRIVACY

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Student information:

Student information will not be shared with immigration authorities without parental consent, a court order, or a legal subpoena, unless allowed by the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA).

Visitor check in:

All visitors, including immigration enforcement officers, must check in with the principal or their designee when entering school grounds during school hours.

Visitors will need to provide their name, address, occupation, age (if under 21), reason for being on school grounds, proof of identity, and any other information required by law.

Parental consent:

District staff will get parental consent before a student is interviewed or searched by an officer enforcing immigration laws, unless the officer has a valid court order or warrant.

Notification:

The parent or guardian will be notified immediately if law enforcement seeks to access the student, unless the court order or warrant restricts this notification.

Key documents:

Students and families should know important emergency contacts and where to find key documents, like birth certificates, passports, and medical information, to be prepared if a family member is detained or deported.
