### Jan. 15: PTO "Dine to Donate" @ Giovanni's Pizza



### ★ Student Absences

If your student is going to be absent from school, please email <u>creekviewattendance@mevsd.us</u> or contact the **attendance call line at (937) 578-6615** before 9:00 a.m. When notifying the school of your student's absence please include the following information:

- Student First & Last Name
- Grade / Team / Homeroom
- Reason for Absence / Expected Return Date
- Your Name and Relationship to Student

Once your student returns to school, please provide the office with a parent note or doctor excuse.

### ★ Normal School Day Hours

**Arrival:** Creekview interior doors will open at 8:15 a.m. Students dropped off prior to 8:15 a.m. will not have access to the building. The tardy bell rings at 8:35 a.m. Students not in their homeroom at 8:35 a.m., will be marked tardy.

**Dismissal:** All Creekview students will be dismissed at 3:15 p.m.

### ★ Students going home different than their "Normal Procedure"

Anytime your child will be going home after school different from their "Normal Procedure", please send in a note (or email) to your child's teacher &/or the front office at

<u>Creekviewattendance@mevsd.us</u> . *Please include your child's first and last name*. If somebody other than a parent/guardian will be picking up your child, please include their name in the note signed by a parent/guardian.

**PLEASE NOTE:** A bus student cannot take a friend home on the bus unless PRIOR permission is given by the District Transportation Department.

### ★ Change in Address:

If your permanent residency address has changed, please notify the school office immediately. You will be required to fill out a change of address form and provide a new proof of residency - The following are accepted: \*current gas, electric or water bill that has your or your spouse's name and address on it. It can also be a screen printing of an online gas, electric or water bill as long as the company name, your or your spouse's name and address are showing. \*Lease or rental agreement SIGNED by both the Landlord and yourself \*Mortgage Statement \*signed purchase agreement or settlement statement for a new home. (must be followed up with a gas, water or electric bill) \*If you are living with another family and do not have any of the above in your name, a Residency Affidavit must be completed, notarized and returned with one of the bills above in the home owner's name. / Required Change of Address Form (Versión en español)

#### **BLESSINGS IN A BACKPACK 2024-25**

Your child may be eligible to be a recipient of the Blessings in a Backpack program and once the program is implemented, will receive a bag of non-perishable food every Friday during the school year. If your child is currently enrolled in, or if they will be enrolled in the free or reduced lunch program for the 2024-2025 school year, your child is



eligible for Blessings in a Backpack. Backpacks will be dispensed in a discreet and caring manner. This program runs the full school year. There is no cost associated with this program. If you wish for your child to participate in the program you need to fill out an information sheet (link below).
