The Morris County Career Training Center (MCCTC) is part of the Morris County Vocational School District, located on the campus of the County College of Morris in Randolph. The building will house 10 Share-Time Programs designed to provide high school juniors and seniors with school-to-work options. Students will earn industry credentials, college credits and participate in work-based learning opportunities.
