- **Please be mindful of the staff and student foot traffic on and around our campus**

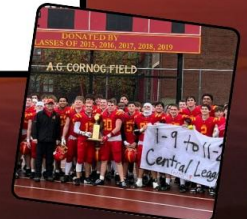
