Available Grants

Families can opt-in for the Ray & Marie Miller grant which does not require income verification. Opt-in form will be emailed to parents of eligible students in June.

- Ray & Marie Miller opt-in grant for grades 6-8 is: \$200/student
- Ray & Marie Miller opt-in grant for grades 9-12 is: \$500/student

Wisconsin Parental Choice Program (WPCP)

Application Period: First weekday in February through the third Thursday in April.

This grant program through the Department of Public Instruction (DPI) provides funding to eligible SMCS students in grades 4K-12.

SMCS Tuition Assistance Program

Priority Application Period: March 1-March 31, 2024. There will be a \$40 application fee after these dates. SMCS has many generous donors that love to help families make Catholic education affordable. Families who do not meet the WPCP criteria are encouraged to apply for these donor funds using the FACTS Tuition Management online assistance application.
