Brown Act, the Board is unable to respond to any individual comments or questions regarding items not on the agenda; however, the Board listens carefully to, and reads, all public comments and appreciates community input and participation. The Board reserves the right to mute or remove a participant from the meeting if the participant unreasonably disrupts the Board meeting.
