

FREE DENTAL DECAY PREVENTION PROGRAM

Dear Parent/Caregiver:

Tooth decay (cavities) is the most common chronic disease found in children.

A registered dental hygienist or dentist will assess your child's teeth and apply a protective coating called fluoride varnish to your child's teeth. Fluoride varnish is a protective coating that is painted on teeth. The varnish strengthens teeth and prevents tooth decay. The coating should remain on the teeth until the teeth are brushed the next day.
