What are Flexible Instruction Days?

Remote learning days that count toward the number of hours and school days required under Article 15 of the Public School Code

FIDs are designed to provide a continuity of instruction in the event a regularly scheduled school day is cancelled (primarily due to weather closures).

How will students, parents, and guardians be notified of a Flexible Instruction Day?

- Notification will be accomplished via our automated calling system, website, Facebook, and Channels 2, 4, and 11 newscasts.
- Call will include information indicating that a Flexible Instruction Day will be used for the school cancellation
- Additionally, the announcement will be posted on the Lenape Tech website and social media
- Regular snow days will be used first in most circumstances

How will FIDs work for Lenape Tech?



On days when school cannot be open due to inclement weather or another significant event, students will stay home to complete their lessons remotely for that day.



Students must be logged in and communicate with their 1st Period teacher for attendance purposes.

Students must then complete the posted assignments for all classes to receive credit for the school day.

How will student attendance work for FIDs?

- It will be the responsibility of the student to login to Teams between the hours of 9:30am and 12pm, and again from 12:40pm to 2:20pm, the equivalent of an in-person instructional day (2hr delay schedule). The student will access the assignments posted for each class according to provided instructions.
- There will not be TAP assignments on Flex Days

What is expected of students on a FID day?

What are the student expectations during FID's?

- Login to Teams platform by 9:30am
- Access Flex Day folders for each of their classes
- Follow instructions for Flex Day assignments
- Participate in the associated learning activities according to the provided instructions
- Class schedule will follow the 2-hour delay (next slide)
- Submit assignments according to the provided instructions
- Lunchtime is observed from 12:00pm until 12:40pm
- Student day will end at 2:20pm

What is expected of students on a FID day?

Flexible Instruction Day Class Schedule

- 09:30am- 1st period (attendance will be taken)
- 10:10am- 2nd period
- 10:50am- 3rd period
- 11:30am- 4th period
- 12:00pm- Lunch
- 12:40pm- 5th period
- 1:20pm- 6th period
- 2:20pm- End of Flex Day (teachers are available for tutoring and remediation)

What is expected of students on a FID day?

- Students are expected to work on assignments from home that have been posted on our school-wide Microsoft Teams and Office Suite.
- Hard copies may be provided based on student need and by request.
- All instructors will work with students to ensure that prior to any closure, students have access to the assignments posted and will have the option of working “offline” in the event of technical/connectivity issues students may experience.
- A school device such as a laptop can be provided to students who do not have an appropriate device at home to ensure equity and participation.

How will support be provided to students with special needs?

- The FID lessons will be designed for students with special needs by utilizing their program modifications, specially designed instruction, and supplementary aids and services identified in their individualized education plan or 504 service agreements
- Upon return from a FID, teachers of students with special needs will meet with their students to review the work submitted, checking for completion and understanding
- If needed, students will have an additional 3 school days to complete these assignments

How will support be provided to students with special needs?

- Parents may call 724-763-7116 for the teacher directory, or to speak with a secretary who can assist them.
- Students that require accommodations can communicate with paraprofessionals (Instructional Assistants) throughout the day via Teams or Email.
