SBCOE to Host Annual Literacy Summit January 23

San Benito County Office of Education is hosting its 2nd Annual Literacy Summit to promote and improve literacy for students in San Benito county on January 23 from 4:30 to 7:00pm at the Veteran's Memorial Building. This year's theme is "Words and Numbers: The Building Blocks of Literacy," and is designed for educators, families, and community members to collaboratively explore the critical role of language and numeracy in literacy development.

This year's Literacy Summit features sessions on best practices in reading, writing, and math skills. Attendees will gain valuable insights and practical strategies to support children's literacy growth at home and in school. Through interactive workshops and expertled discussions, participants will learn how literacy encompasses both language and numeracy skills. The summit promotes a holistic view of literacy, showing that reading and math together form the foundation for lifelong learning.

In addition to an awards ceremony recognizing student literacy and math champions, participants will hear from keynote speaker, Dr. Greg Spencer and enjoy roundtable discussions led by San Benito County educational leaders. All families, educators, support staff, and



leaders in San Benito county are invited to attend the Summit, which will include a free dinner, networking opportunities, SWAC bags filled with resources and raffle prizes. keynote speaker, and roundtable discussions on various literacy topics. 


These events were made possible by the generosity and dedication of our partners and community members. Thank you for helping us make a difference for local students and families this holiday season!
