



Dear Catholic Academy of Sussex County Family –

PowerSchool, a software vendor which provides our Student Information System (SIS), recently experienced a cybersecurity incident.

PowerSchool has informed our leadership team that they experienced a cybersecurity incident involving unauthorized access to certain PowerSchool SIS customer data. Unfortunately, they have confirmed that some of the information belongs to Catholic Academy of Sussex County families and educators.

PowerSchool informed us that the taken data primarily includes parent and student contact information with names and addresses information. Across their customer base, they have determined that some individuals' personally identifiable information (PII), such as social security numbers (SSN) and medical information, was also taken. They are working urgently to complete their investigation and determine whether PII belonging to our students was included.

Protecting our students is something we take seriously. With PowerSchool's help, we will provide more information and resources (including credit monitoring or identity protection services if applicable) to you as they become available.
