Employee Assistance Program

Hattiesburg Public School District's Employee Assistance Program (EAP) provides employees with help with personal problems that may interfere with job performance or the quality of their lives.

EAP offers a variety of confidential services to employees and their families including free assessments, referrals, counseling, and educational information to assist in resolving personal problems.

Self-referral: An employee recognizes that there is a problem and calls the EAP office to schedule an assessment. After the assessment, a recommendation and referral will be made and counseling or treatment may then begin.

Confidentiality: All contacts with EAP are handled professionally and are strictly confidential.

Services available through EAP: Adult Individual Therapy, Child and Adolescent Therapy, Family Therapy, Marital Therapy & Quarterly Management and Employee Educational In-Services.

EAP Offers assistance for employees with: Stress, Anxiety, Depression, Grief, Divorce, Addiction, Trauma and Family Conflict.

Eligibility and Fees: EAP services are available to HPSD full-time and part-time employees receiving benefits and their insurance eligible dependents. Each individual is eligible for five (5) counseling sessions per year at no charge.
