<p>January 27-31, 2025</p>	<p>Teachers Make Core Recommendations in Infinite Campus</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> During this week, teachers will be conducting 1:1 meetings with students in class to recommend them for their next course. This is the best opportunity for your student to ask questions about the recommendations being made and why. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Teachers use multiple data points beyond grades to determine a student’s placement (<i>including but not limited to: time-management skills, maturity, ability to work with others, ability to advocate for self if struggling</i>).
<p>February 5, 2025</p>	<p>Students Receive Course Selection Forms in 2nd Period</p> <p>On Wednesday, February 5 students will receive their Course Selection Forms during 2nd Period. Students with no 2nd period (online, DE, etc.) can pick up their forms from Mrs. Hatfield (Suite 1340) or Mrs. Verges (Suite 1360).</p> <p>Critical Information About Course Selection</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> This is when your student has the opportunity to make “free for all” changes to courses, regardless of the teacher recommendation. If students want to drop down in rigor, they must indicate such on the form. If students are waiving to go into a more rigorous course than recommended, this is when they must sign the Honors/AP Waiver. If students want to take an online course for the 2025-2026 School Year, this is when they select the online course and complete the online course contract. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> If you wish to take a course that requires an audition or application, make sure you write in an additional back-up option in the event you are not accepted into your desired course.
<p>February 6-7, 2025</p>	<p>Counselors Accepting STUDENT Walk-Ins for Course Selection Questions</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Students are encouraged to come between classes, during lunch, or with teacher permission and pass. This is for STUDENTS only. If you are a PARENT with a question or concern, reach out to your assigned counselor via phone or email.
<p>February 12, 2025</p>	<p>Course Selection Forms DUE for Students</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Students must return their Course Selection Forms to their assigned counselor by the end of the day on Wednesday, February 12. <p>February 21, 2025</p>	<p>Students Receive Verification of Changes</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Students will receive a Verification of Change Form during 2nd period on Friday, February 21. <u>This is your copy to keep, verifying that the changes you requested were made.</u> Students will not be making any additional changes to their requests at this time.
<p>March 31, 2025</p>	<p>Dual Enrollment Paperwork Deadline</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> If your student is planning to participate in Dual Enrollment for the 2025-2026 School Year, ALL paperwork must be submitted to the <u>assigned counselor</u> by March 31, 2025. This is a <i>hard county deadline</i> – no paperwork will be accepted after this date. Students are encouraged to follow the processes and deadlines posted on the Milton Dual Enrollment Page.

March 31-April 4, 2025

FINAL REVIEW of Course Selections + Teacher Adjustment to Recommendations (if applicable)

On **Monday, March 31** students will receive a copy of their Course Selection Forms during 2nd Period. Students with no 2nd period (online, DE, etc.) can pick up their forms from Mrs. Hatfield (Suite 1340) or Mrs. Verges (Suite 1360).

Critical Information About The FINAL REVIEW Of Course Selection Form

- All courses should be exactly as you selected in February. We understand that circumstances change between February-April and want to be mindful of your needs.
- This is the FINAL opportunity for your student to waive into an Honors/AP Course.
- This is the FINAL opportunity for your student to opt into or out of an online course (FVS/GAVS).
- **IF any changes must be made, they are DUE to your assigned counselor by Friday, April 4, 2025.**
