














Kindergarten Eligibility

August 31 vs. September 1-October 31

- Students must be five on or before August 31
- Students born after August 31st but before November 1st must go through the Early Entrance process

Assessments for Early Entrance

Assessments include cognitive, academic, and other school readiness measures

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WA Kids Assessment & Start of School

With the funding of full-day kindergarten, all schools now utilize the WA Kids assessment in Kindergarten.

This involves meeting with families prior to the start of school and ongoing observational assessment throughout the school year.

The first day of kindergarten starts three days *after* grades 1st -5th start.

The draft calendar for the 2025-2026 school year has been released on the BSD website. The first day of school is Tuesday, September 2^{nd} for grades $1^{st} - 12^{th}$. Kindergarten will start on Friday, September 5^{th} .

A Typical Kindergarten Day



- Calendar
- Literacy: Reading, Writing, Listening, Speaking
 - Includes Foundational Reading Skills
- Social Emotional Learning*
- Snack
- Math
- Recess/Lunch 20 minutes Recess and 25 minutes Lunch
- Science or Social Studies
- Specialist: Art, Music, PE, and Library
- Afternoon Recess
- Circle Time
- Dismissal

*Note that social emotional learning is woven in throughout all subject areas but is also taught as a stand-alone subject as well.

Attendance: School Starts at 8 AM

- Each day of learning is essential to your child's progress and academic and social success.
- Please do not schedule vacations or other trips which take away from your child's learning.
- All students need to be in their classroom by 8:00am or they will be considered tardy. Regular, on time attendance in the early primary grades sets a pattern for students throughout their educational career.







Lunch

Students may bring lunch from home or receive a school lunch.

Lunch during the 24-25 school year is \$4.00.

- Breakfast is \$2.25.
- Milk is \$.50.

Families can apply for free/reduced priced meals online. We can help you with this!

Lunch is eaten in our "Cafe" and is supervised by our General School Assistant Team known as CCRs (Classroom-Cafeteria-Recess Teachers).

Kindergarten Success

Build your child's independence: zipping coat, packing bag, cleaning up

- Follow two step directions
 - e.g. "First do _____, then do _____."

Build your child's confidence in talking and working with new people

- Talk with people such as librarians at the library
- Encourage your child to speak for them self

Kindergarten Readiness

Social (Taking turns, Following directions)

Emotional (Separates easily, eager to learn) uses words to express needs

Plays Games (Taking turns, good winner/loser) sharing materials

Health (Manipulates clothing, toileting independently)Fine Motor (Tying shoes, cutting, gluing, holding a pencil)Gross Motor (Run, skips, hops, jumps)



Readiness Indicators Look Like....

Note: Kids are on a continuum of development and do not show 100% proficiency in all areas. Students all have strengths and areas to encourage development.



How to Prepare!


• PLAY:

- Games & Dramatic play
- Stories & Puppets
- Create with objects
- Playdough, Scissors & Pincer Grasp

• TALK:

- Model Naming Emotions
- Describe Environment
- Counting & Quantifying
- Sounds & Rhyming
- SCHEDULE
 - Consistency
 - Clear expectations
 - Signs/Visuals
